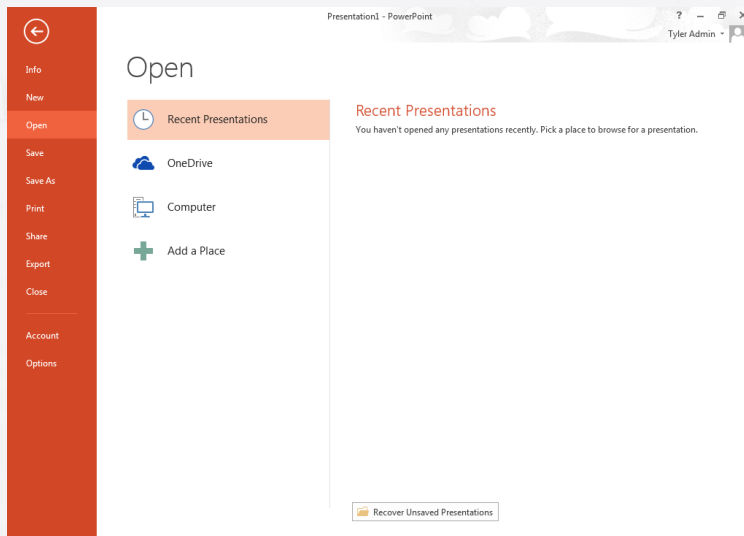
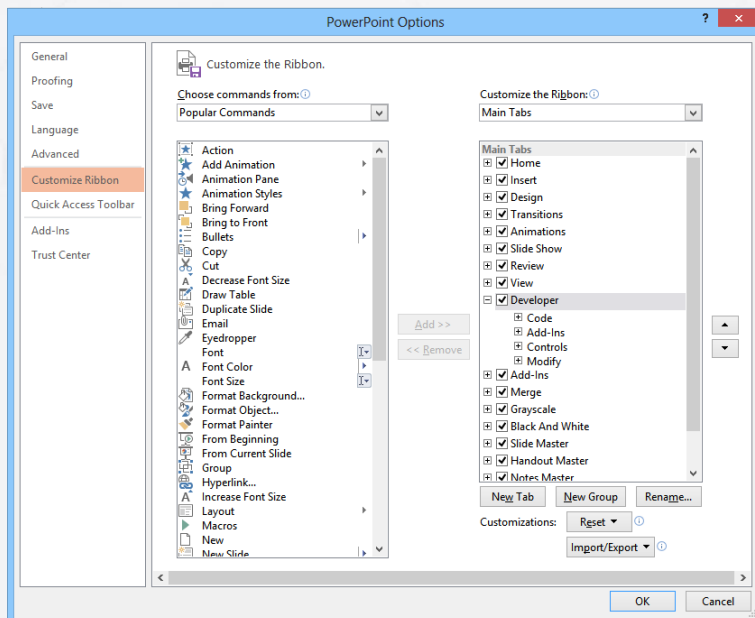


Adding YouTube Video into a Presentation

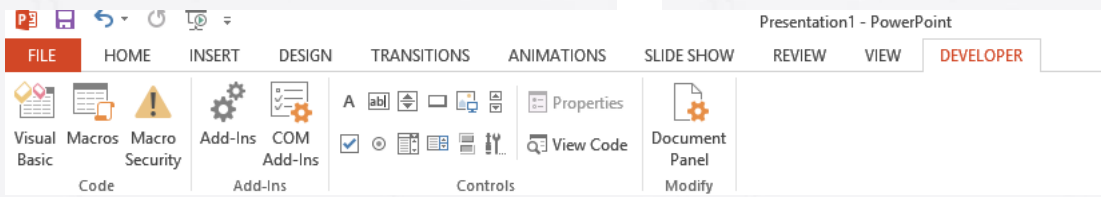
Go to "File" then "Options" and then to the "Customize Ribbon" tab



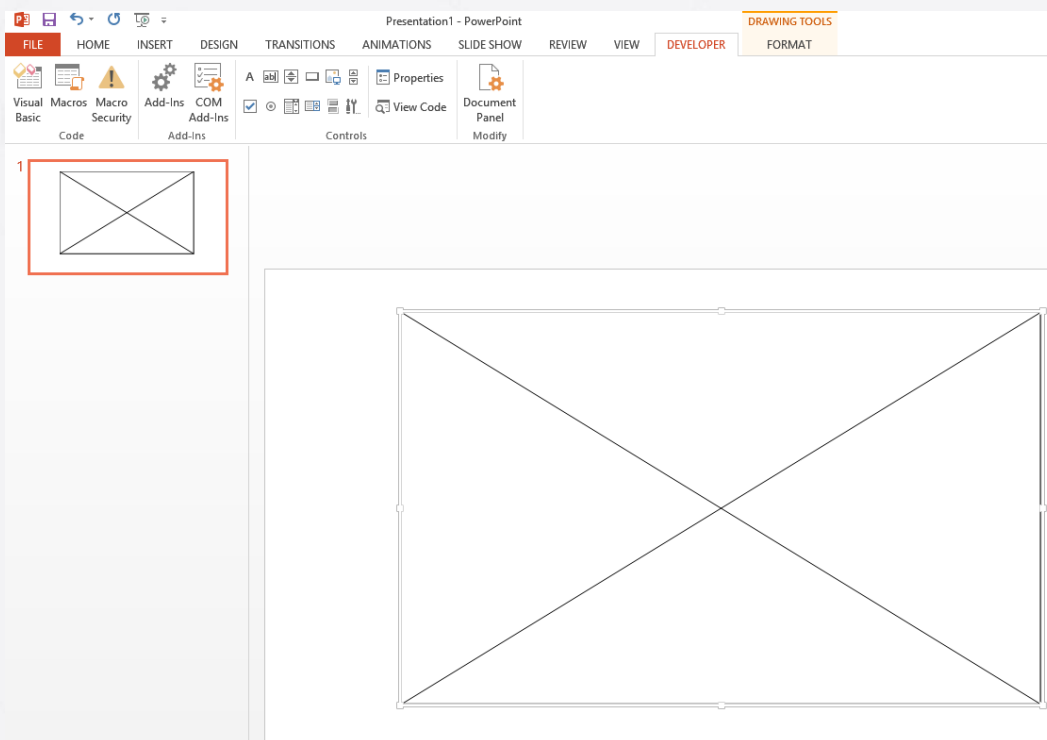
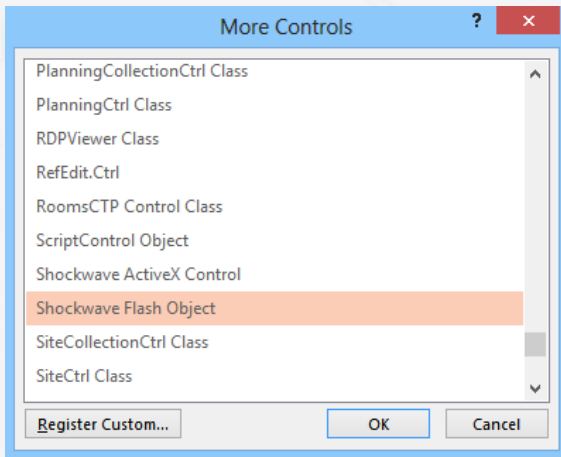
Enable Developer Tab
