

KS3 Curriculum - PSHRE

Subject: PSHRE

Year Group:7

Term	Key Topic(s) Covered
1	<p>In RE we shall be carrying out an introduction to the 6 main world religions covering a range of key details about their origin, history and practice. Students will undertake group work exploring what it means to be a member of one of these religions.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at emotional health and wellbeing in particular how to deal with negative emotions.</p>
2	<p>In RE we will be thinking about what makes human beings special and what we mean by the human spirit. Students will be exploring the idea of the value and purpose of human life.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be covering puberty and life changes.</p>
3	<p>In RE we will be looking at the role of prayer and what is meant by religious experience. We will consider the importance of time to reflect and contemplation.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at the issue of smoking.</p>
4	<p>In RE we will be finding out about festivals. We will be exploring the way religions reflect their beliefs and values about the preciousness of the world in their celebrations and festivals.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at issues around alcohol.</p>
5	<p>In RE we will be exploring the impact of religion and belief in the local community, in and around BANES, in the UK and in the global community.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at the issue of bullying.</p>
6	<p>In RE we will be finding out about the value and status of holy books in different religions. Students will be carrying out a group work project and thinking about the concept of truth and the value of teachings.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at how we develop our personal values.</p>

Term	Key Topic(s) Covered
1	<p>In RE we will be examining the concepts of identity and belonging. We will consider how people express their deepest values and commitments in creative ways and look at the different ways individuals express their sense of identity and key beliefs.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at issues around smoking and alcohol.</p>
2	<p>In RE we will be thinking about ideas about life after death and the meaning of life. We will look at religious and non religious ideas about what happens after death and look at the impact that these beliefs have on the way individuals live their lives.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be learning basic first aid.</p>
3	<p>In RE we will be considering issues for poverty and injustice. We will consider why there is suffering in the world and will look at the role religion and beliefs play in encouraging their members to be a force for good in the world.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be developing ways to resolve conflict.</p>
4	<p>In RE we will be thinking about attitudes towards the environment and what religions say about conservation and stewardship. We will consider whether things are getting better or worse for the environment and the reasons for this. Students will complete a group work project on creation stories from different traditions.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at issues relating to prejudice and discrimination.</p>
5	<p>In RE we will be looking at the way individuals express their sense of identity within their community. We shall be focusing primarily on the Sikh community and students will have the opportunity to visit a Gurdwara in Bristol.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at respectful relationships.</p>
6	<p>In RE we will be looking at the role of religious leaders in local, national and global communities. Students will carry out a research project and present their findings to the class in an oral report.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at bullying.</p>

Year Group: 9

Term	Key Topic(s) Covered
1	<p>In RE and PSHE we will be looking at issues relating to Human Rights. Our studies will include the Holocaust and the lessons which must be learned from history and modern day slavery on Cocoa plantations on the Ivory Coast.</p>
2	<p>In RE we will be carrying out a research project into a moral issue such as abortion, euthanasia, animal testing... Students will consider a range of views on their chosen issue and evaluate their validity.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at issues relating to self-esteem and body image.</p>
3	<p>In RE we will be considering the idea of interfaith dialogue and how members of different religious traditions and none can relate to each other and work together to aid mutual understanding and pull communities together.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at issues relating to sex and relationships.</p>
4	<p>In RE we will be exploring the philosophical issues relating to the origins of the universe. Students will explore ideas about creation and the Big Bang and what is meant by the term 'truth'.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at issues relating to alcohol.</p>
5	<p>In RE we will be exploring the way the media portrays religion and belief and assessing its fairness. We will also be using a range of media to portray religion and beliefs ourselves.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at issues relating to drug use and abuse.</p>
6	<p>In RE we will be exploring the religious traditions which students will study in depth at GCSE. Students who have opted for full course GCSE will be researching the beliefs and practises of Buddhists. The rest of the students will be gaining an insight into Islam and Hinduism.</p> <p>In PSHE we will be looking at issues relating to personal identity.</p>
