Key Vocabulary	Definition
<b>Reverb</b>	A sound effect that replicates the reflection characteristics of a given room/place
<b>Delay</b>	An “echo” style sound effect
<b>Equalisation</b>	Or EQ. Boosting or cutting specific frequencies on a track (or sound)
<b>Beatmatch</b>	When two musical recordings are moved to the same tempo (BPM)
<b>BPM</b>	Beat per minute
<b>Loop</b>	A continuous repeat applied to a region/track on garageband
<b>Glitch</b>	When the music (often a loop) has an unwanted skip/click/jump out of time.
<b>Pan</b>	The button on a mixing desk that controls where a sound is in the stereo field
<b>Mute</b>	Silencing a track (or tracks) to allow specific focus
<b>Solo</b>	Enabling a track (or tracks) to allow specific focus
<b>Four on the floor</b>	A regular 4 beat kick drum beat
<b>Filtersweep</b>	A effect that gradually applies a cut or boost to specific frequencies over time
