The students were very professional and made a fantastic impression on the staff there, so much so that they've been invited back to lead an INSET training for all of their staff. This project was in conjunction with 'Teach the Teacher', an organisation who have trained our students to be able to do this. As a school, we look forward to completing our own staff training which will be delivered by the Climate Action Team.

The silver ribbons reflect MEER's use of mirrors to deflect sunlight back into space rather than allowing it to convert into heat by being absorbed into the ground and heating up the air. #### Mind over Mile Charity 2wish in School on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> July

The charity offers support to families affected by the sudden and unexpected death of a child or young person aged 25 and under and the charity has so far supported over 1,400 families who have lost a child or young person. Working hand in hand with organisations such as the Police, NHS Wales and Organ Donation Wales, it provides support to make sure that no family is missed.
